

## **Puppy Chow**

12-14oz of chocolate chips  
1 cup of creamy peanut butter  
1 tablespoon of vanilla  
1 stick of butter (I recommend cutting into small chunks so that it melts faster)  
9 cups of corn or rice chex  
1 bag of powdered sugar (Might be called confetti sugar)  
Sandwich bags

### The Messy Version

Measure out the nine cups into a large mixing bowl

In a pot, melt the chocolate chips on medium-low heat (if at any time it starts to burn a little, add a little milk to soften it again)

After the chocolate chips melt, add in the peanut butter, vanilla, and butter, stirring constantly until completely melted.

Pour on top of the cereal and mix as best you can with two spoons, trying not to crunch the cereal.

Once most of the cereal is covered with the chocolate/peanut butter mixture, pour the powdered sugar on top and mix it all in with your hands, covering as much of the sugar onto the cereal as you can.

### NON-Messy Version

Everything is the same except instead of putting into a bowl put it in a gallon size zip-loc bag to mix.

Please fill sandwich bags about 1/3 full and seal.
